
#### **Quality Improvement Program Support Strategies**

We support and encourage educators to attend trainings and return to school for a bachelor's degree. Coaching staff meet on a regular basis to review work, work load, and services needed.


#### Local Approach to Offering Financial Incentives and Stipends


## How Children Are Served by QCC




#### **QCC Settings**




**Children Served by Setting** 




## **Children's Races and Ethnicities**
