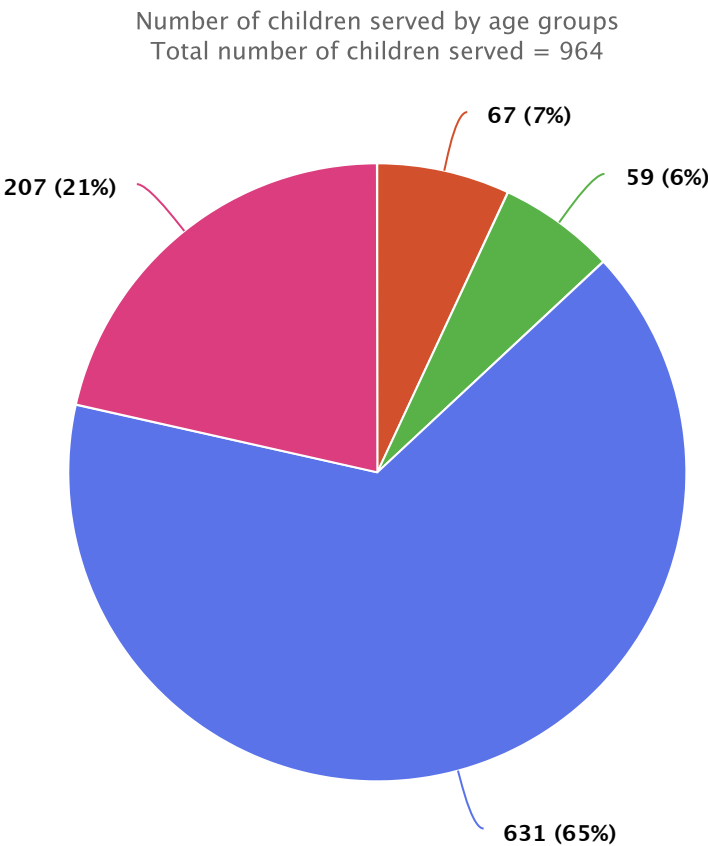

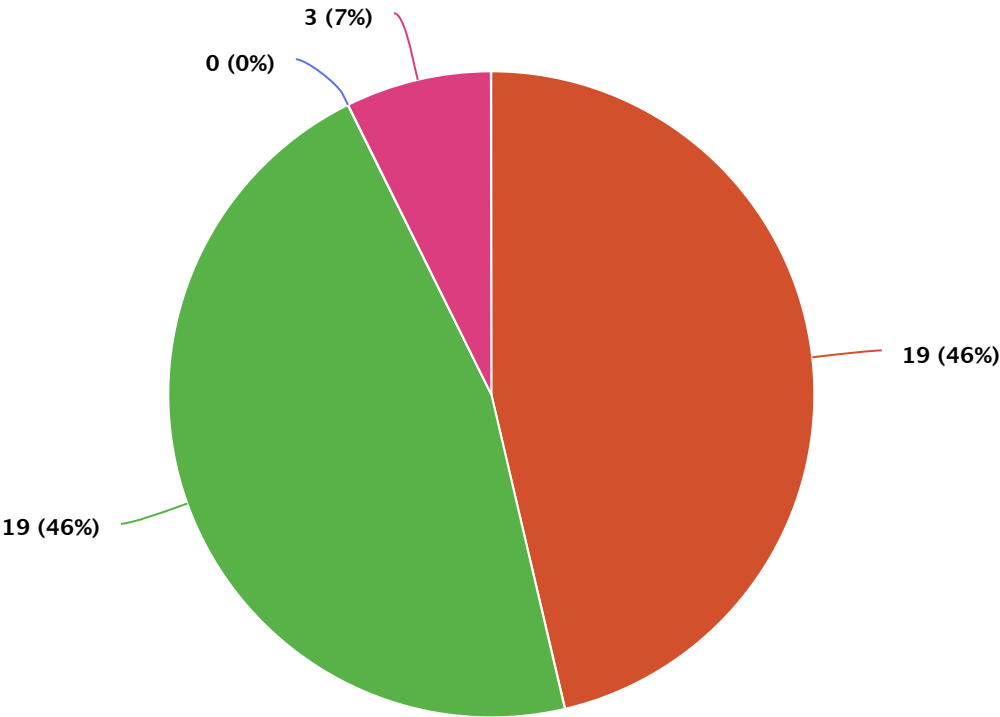

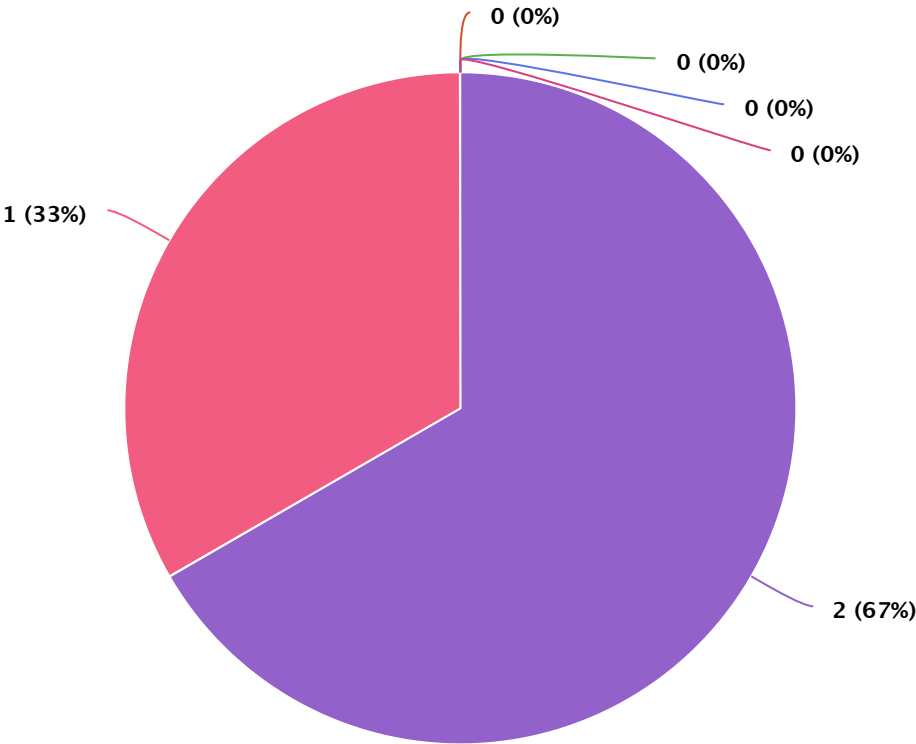
Early care and education (ECE) providers participating in QCC

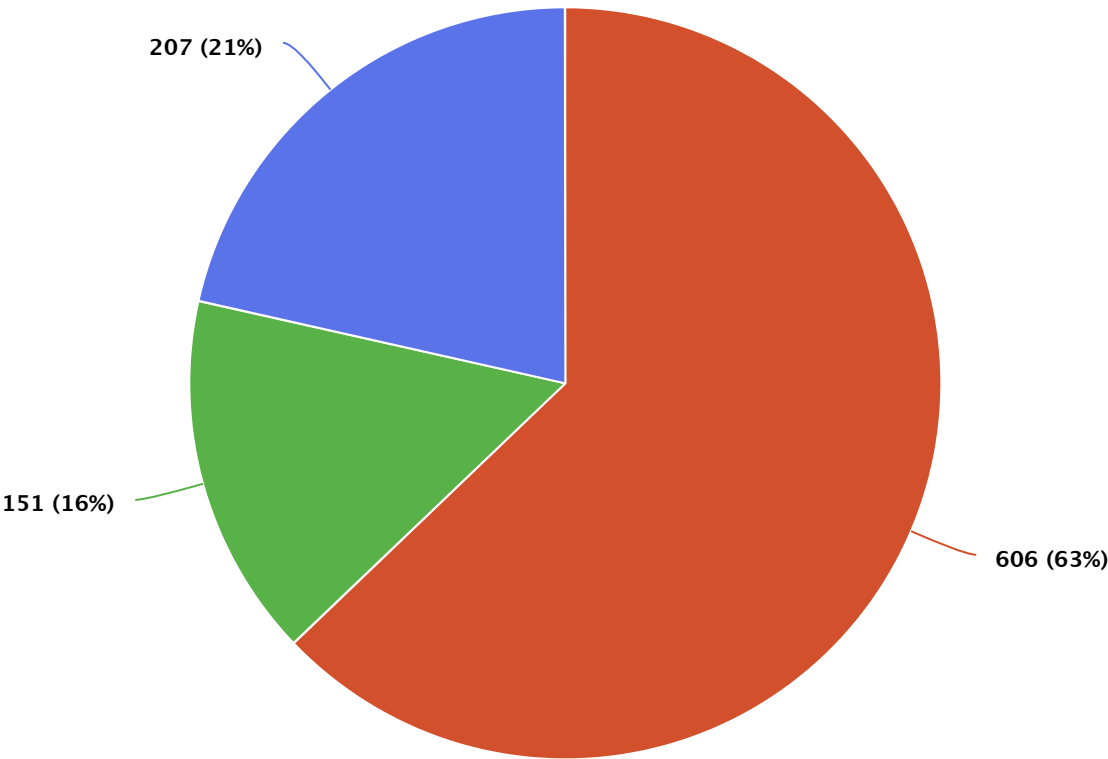

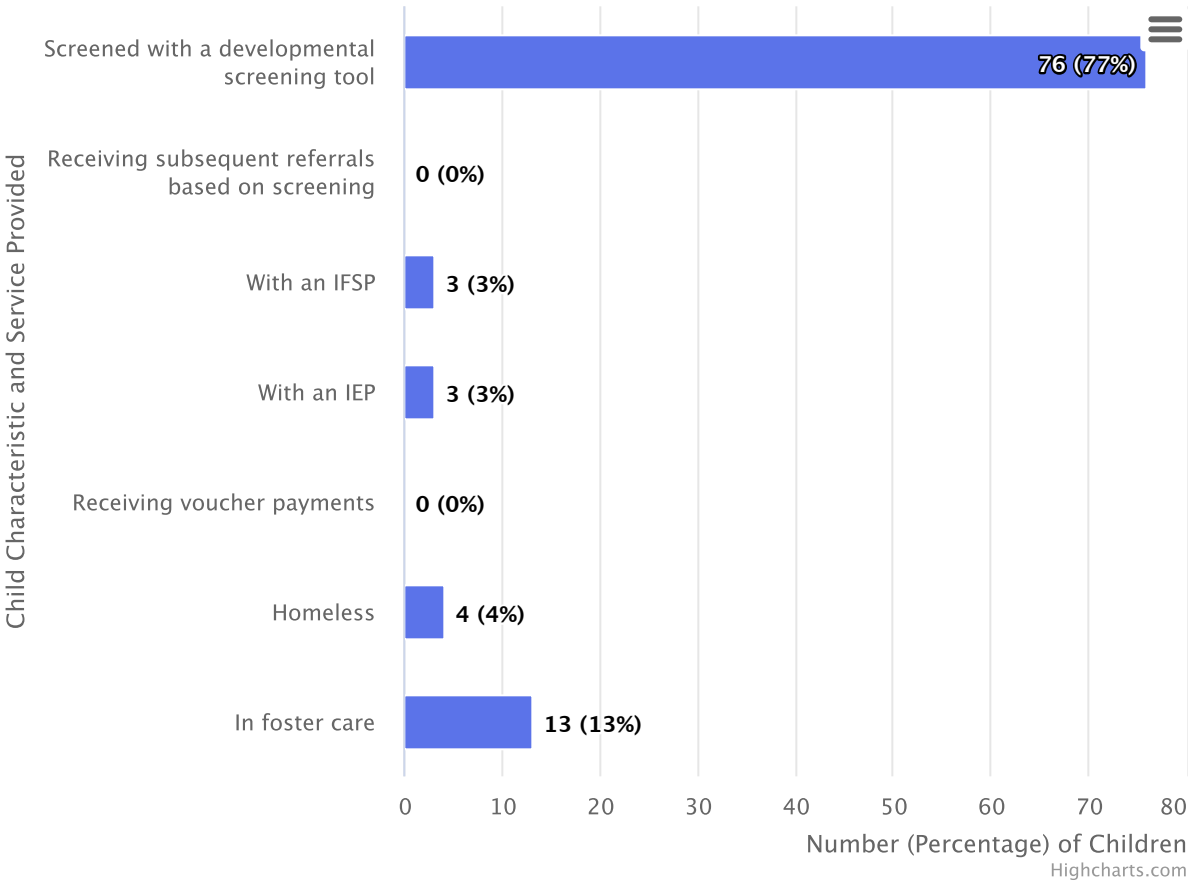
Children Served by Setting

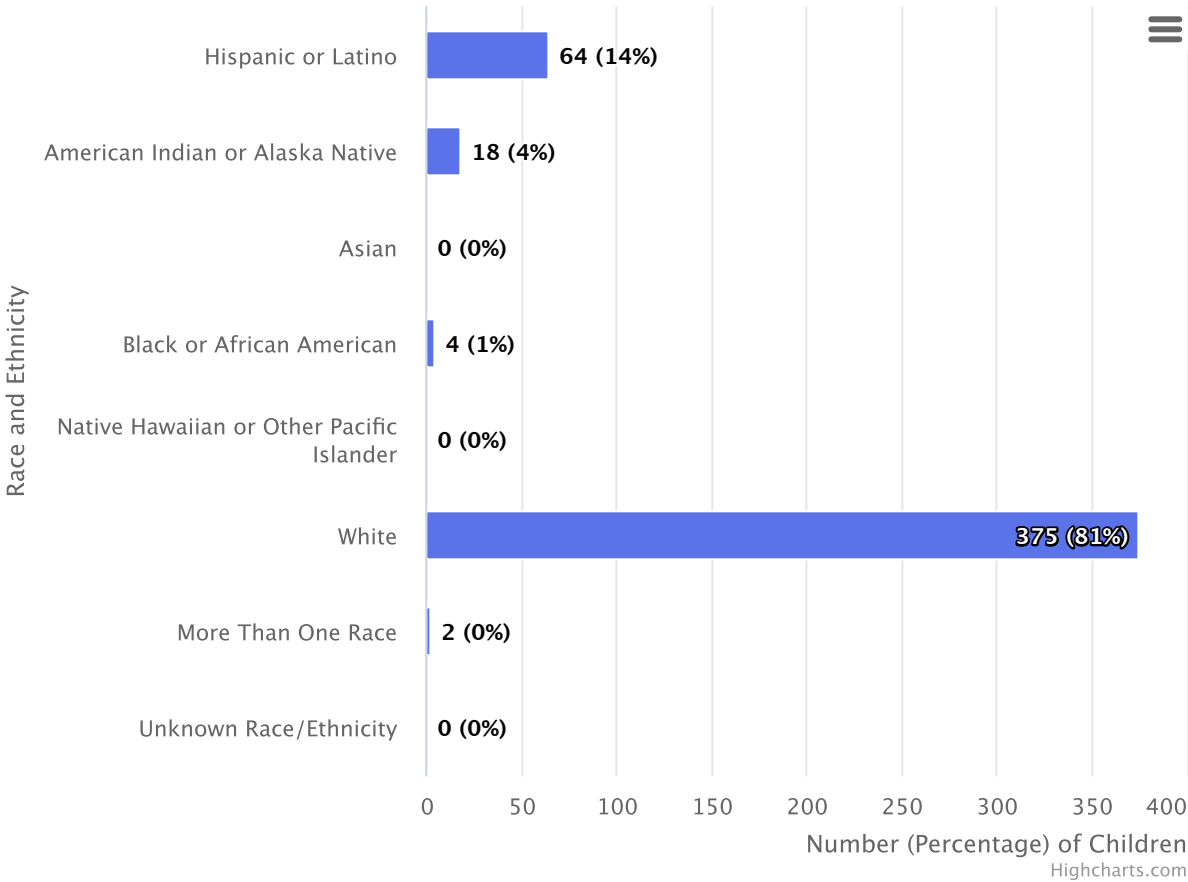

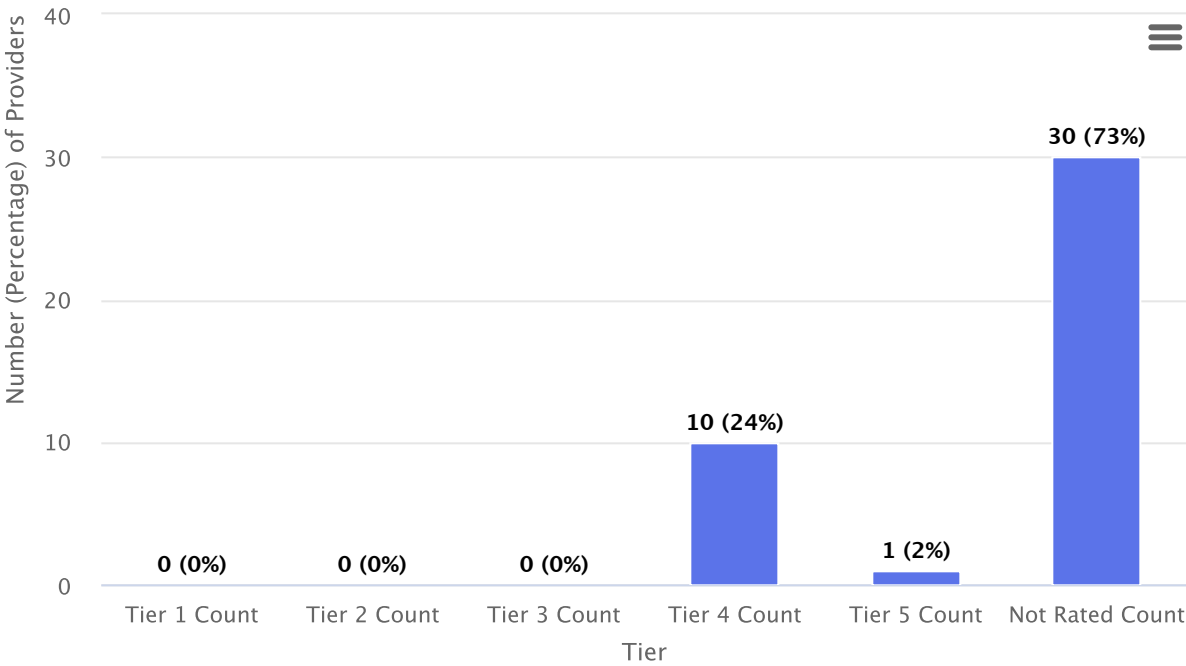
Overall Child Characteristics and Services Provided



Children’s Races and Ethnicities



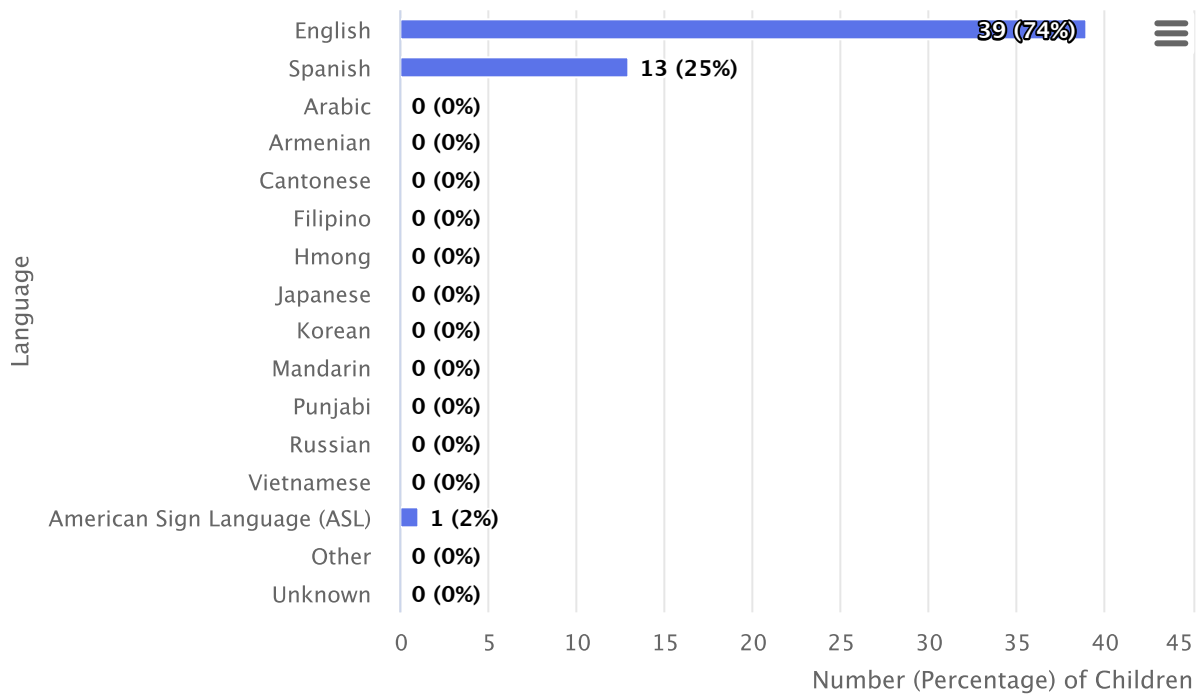
QCC Tier Rating Distribution

Language Spoken with Children

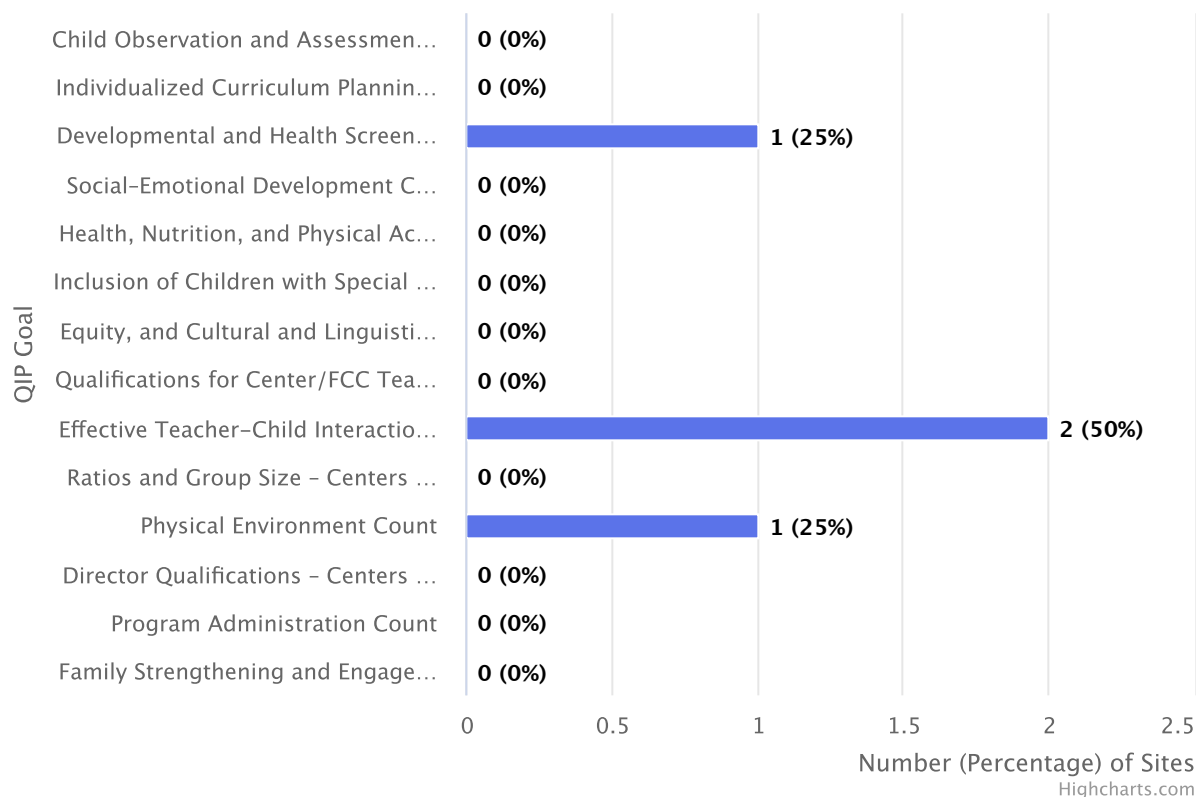
